**Subject: Transparency in disbursement of funds through electronic mode**

In order to ensure financial inclusion of workers and timely payment of their dues it has been decided to launch a campaign to open bank accounts for such workers in the organised and unorganised sectors, who do not have bank accounts even now

A large number of such workers are employed on central projects for HO sites existing and proposed; and various other projects such as Bansagar. Similarly, a large number of workers are employed for Ganga cleaning under the Namami Gange programme. Payments are also being released to the State governments under PMKSY for 99 priority projects. Similarly, funds are released for various Central Sector Schemes to various Organisations of this Ministry. The concerned Organisations utilise these funds by way of payment for salaries, & various bills etc. The payments are also made to various contractors/vendors/consultants/NGOs as may be required in the discharge of their functions.

Field offices as well as the contractors for such works are strictly instructed to open bank accounts for the workers on such projects and to make payments to them through DBT. The entire salary and wages and any other dues have to be paid to staff through electronic mode by transferring amount to their respective accounts. This will not only ensure financial inclusion but also complete transparency in the utilisation of central funds/grants, apart from ease and speed of doing work.

Camps may be organised at the field level in consultation with the concerned Collector and District Magistrate, Lead bank officer of the district, Labour officers of the Centre & State at the district level. The contours of such an exercise have already been discussed with the State Governments and the banks by the Union ministry of Labour and the Department of Financial Services. In case of any problem please let us know, we will be happy to facilitate your work.


