General conditions:

1. Professionals with requisite qualifications and experience as prescribed would be eligible for being engaged as Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow(JRF). However, if suitable NET/GATE qualified candidates are not found, the candidates without these qualifications may be considered but as per the rates mentioned above.
2. Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) would be engaged for a fixed period for providing high quality services to the Institute or for attending to specific and time-bound jobs.
3. The appointment of Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) would be on Full-time basis and they would not be permitted to take up any other assignment during the period of Consultancy with the NIH.
4. The appointment of Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) is purely temporary on co-terminus basis and do not entitle the appointee to any claim implicit or explicit or any NIH post. The appointment can be cancelled at any time by the Institute without assigning any reason.
5. The initial term of appointment and subsequent extension (s) if any, shall be decided on case to case basis depending upon the specific job and the time frame for its completion.
6. The Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) shall not be entitled to any allowance such as Dearness Allowance, Residential Telephone, Transport facility, Personal Staff etc.
7. The Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) may be provided with the transit accommodation as per prevailing rules of the Institute. The applicable licence fee shall be charged and the Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) shall vacate the accommodation on the termination or expiry of the tenure, whichever is earlier.
8. No TA/DA shall be admissible for joining the appointment on contractual basis. Research Scientist/Research Associate (RA)/Junior Research Fellow (JRF) shall be allowed TA/DA for their travel inside the country in connection with the official work.
9. The selection of candidates will be made through Walk-in-Interview. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidate for attending the interview.
