Age relaxation of SC/ST/OBC as per Govt. of India rules (2) Candidate may report in N.I.H., half an hour before Interview time. After starting of Interview, admission in the same will not be allowed (3) The post is purely temporary on co-terminus basis and do not entitle the appointee to any claim implicit or explicit or any NIH post. (4) Candidates can directly attend the walk-in-interview along with complete bio-data, passport size photograph and original proof of qualification and experience. They must also bring with them self-attested copies of their certificates. (5) No TA and DA will be paid for attending the interview. (6) Application Format: Advt.
