Sl. No.	Issue	Recommendations
1.	Syllabus of the question paper for Scientist-B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The question paper should include two sections: 'Section A' and 'Section B'.</li><li><b>Section-A</b> should include questions on current affairs/mental ability/general awareness about water resources and environmental issues etc. (30 marks)</li><li><b>Section-B</b> should have questions of the level of graduation (in case of engineering background candidates) and post graduation level (in case of Science background candidates). Further, Section-B of the paper should contain questions from all fields/disciplines as mentioned in the advertisement. The representation of different disciplines should be judiciously maintained. (70 marks)</li></ul>
2.	Duration of the question paper	Two (02) hours
3.	Total No. of questions in the question paper.	Hundred (100) Multiple Choice questions of one (01) mark each. Each question should have only one answer.
4.	Whether, there shall be a provision of negative marking, if so, the marks awarded for wrong answer.	Yes, negative marking is recommended. Following marking system may be followed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>One mark for each correct answer.</li><li>(-) 0.25 mark for every wrong answer</li><li>(-) 0.25 mark for multiple answers of any question.</li></ul>
5.	Minimum qualifying marks to be obtained by candidate to be called for interview.	(a) General/OBC candidate = 40% marks (b) SC candidate = 30%
6.	Number of candidates to be called for interview against each post of based on the merit in written examination.	In the ratio of 1:6 of the number of posts i.e. upto a maximum of six candidates from written exam merit list for one post.
7.	Any other point/criteria that may be deemed appropriate to be recommended by the Committee.	Smart phones/smart watches/calculators/tablets and any other smart devices etc. should not be allowed in the examination hall.
